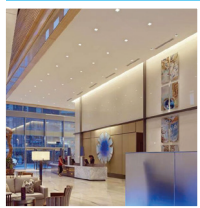

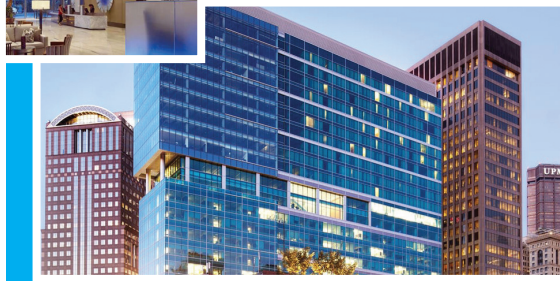
Conference Venue
