Dr. Jeanne Sheffield is the Director of the Maternal-Fetal Medicine Division and a Professor in the Johns Hopkins Medicine Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics. Her areas of clinical and research expertise include medical and surgical complications of pregnancy with a focus on infectious diseases and immunizations in pregnancy. Dr. Sheffield received her undergraduate degree from the University of Notre Dame and earned her medical degree from the University of Alabama at Birmingham. She did her residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology there and then completed a Maternal Fetal Medicine fellowship at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas, Texas. She is board-certified in both Obstetrics and Gynecology as well as Maternal-Fetal Medicine. Dr. Sheffield serves on a number of national boards and committees, is currently on the Board of Directors for the Society of Maternal-Fetal Medicine and serves as the Chair of the MFM Division of the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology. She works with the National Institutes of Health and the CDC helping with Clinical Guideline Development.
