HOW DO WE SUPPORT FAMILIES AFTER PREGNANCY & INFANT LOSS?

Have you ever wondered if you said the wrong thing? Or said nothing at all?

Join us as we navigate pregnancy and infant loss from all perspectives of care. Learn from our professional and parent panels' challenges and opportunities our community allies have experienced. Increase knowledge base for professionals and support staff in the community who encounter families that have experienced pregnancy or infant loss. Develop a resource and referral system of professionals in the community to support and facilitate the families' journey through the loss and grieving process after the hospital discharge.

OBJECTIVES

During this webinar, participants will:

1. Identify empathetic forms of communication to discuss the diagnosis of pregnancy or infant loss
2. Describe the compassionate process that occurs with the patient during labor and birth that are supportive of families experiencing loss
3. Describe the stigma and complicated nature of pregnancy and infant loss and how it differs from other types of grief
4. Identify ways that the community can work together to create awareness and educate all parents on the reality of pregnancy and infant loss
