Program Description:

Resolve Through Sharing® (RTS) Bereavement Training: Perinatal Death is a comprehensive 2-day training in perinatal bereavement education. Attend this training to enhance your knowledge, level of skill, and personal awareness when providing care to families whose baby dies. Online pre-course modules are included with this course.

Training focus: Perinatal death through miscarriage, ectopic pregnancy, stillbirth, and newborn death.
