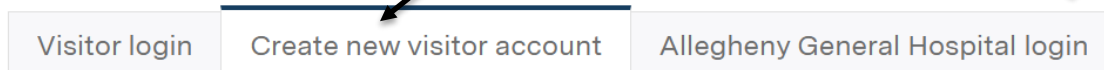
Registration Information

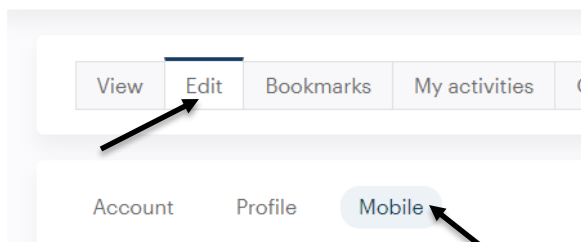
Non-AHN Providers: From *CME Home*, sign in using “Non-Employee/Visitor Login” with existing account or “Register” to “Create New Visitor Account”.
