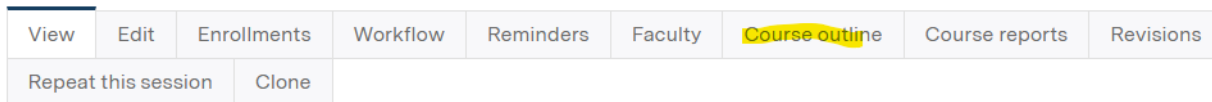
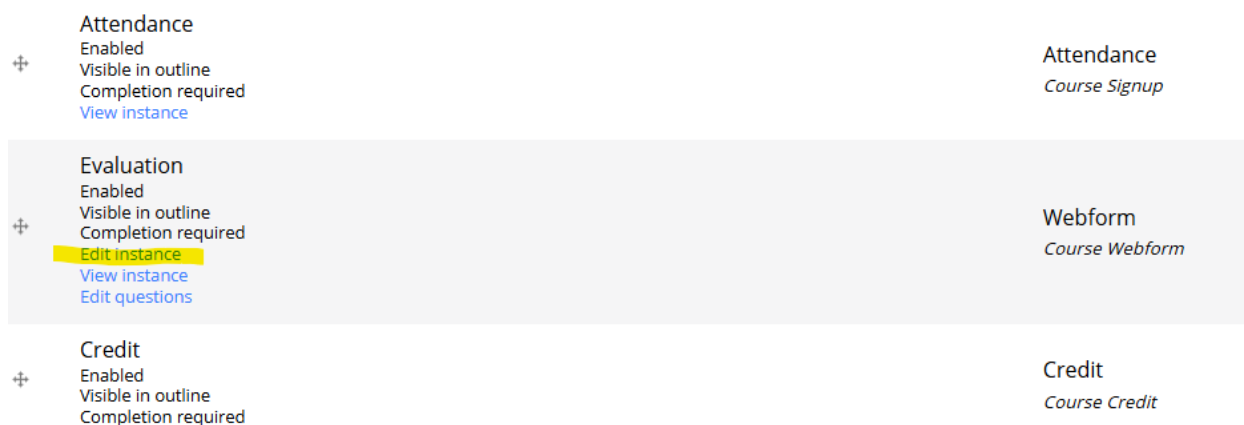


How to add course objectives to your session evaluation in EthosCE

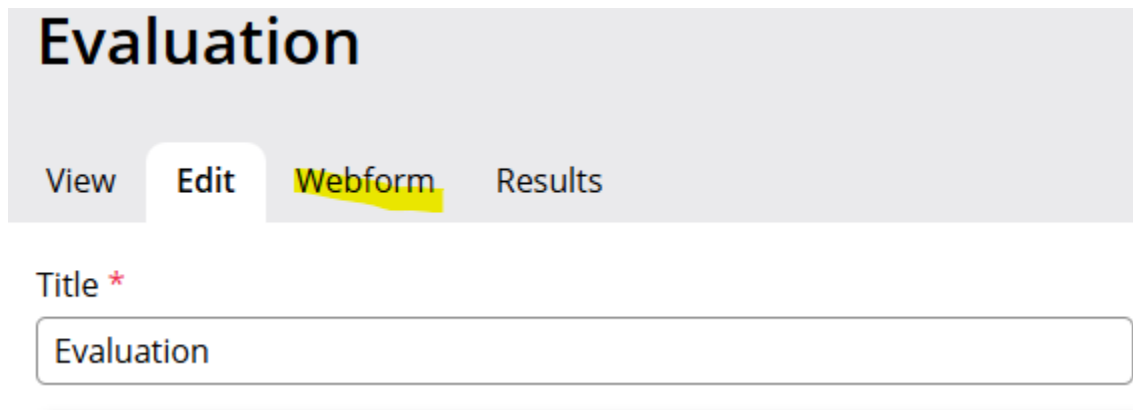
1. Locate your session in EthosCE
2. Click on Course outline



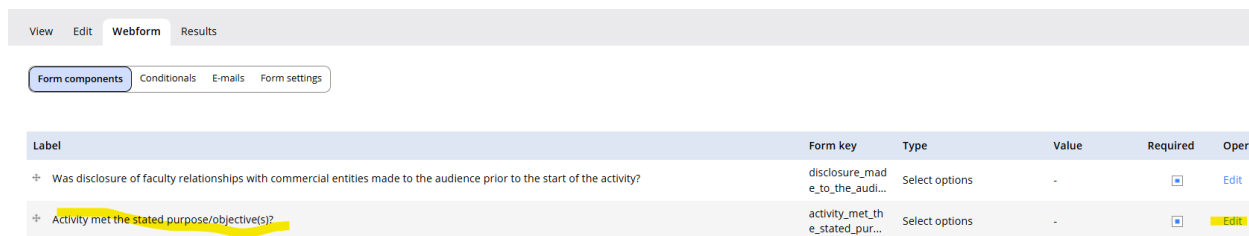
3. Click on edit instance under the Evaluation object



4. Click on Webform



5. Click on Edit (far right) in the row for “Activity met the stated purpose/objective(s)?”

7. In the description box, add the objectives. Note the format is specific and must be numbered followed by the vertical slash. Two to three learning objectives are

sufficient for a 30-to-60-minute CME activity. Remember, objectives must be described using measurable verbs.

8. Final step is to move bottom of page and click on Save component
